MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: June 29, 1992

Released: July 1, 1992

1. National Christian Network, Inc. (NCN) seeks a ruling on a Petition for Leave to Amend. They filed their petition on May 30, 1992, and want to report the steps they will take to eliminate radiation hazards. See DA92-558, released May 14, 1992 at para. 3 and Issue 1. NCN's petition stands unopposed.<sup>1</sup>

Ruling

2. NCN's unopposed petition will be granted and the accompanying amendment accepted. Amending to meet the concerns set out in the Hearing Designation Order constitutes good cause.

So the Petition for Leave to Amend that National Christian Network, Inc. filed on May 30, 1992, IS GRANTED; and the accompanying amendment IS ACCEPTED.
