Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 4, 2018, Paula Boyd, Paul Garnett, and Michael Daum of Microsoft Corporation; Robert McDowell of Cooley LLP; and I met with Julius Knapp, Matthew Hussey, Paul Murray, Karen Rackley, and Hugh Van Tuyl, all of the Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”). We requested that the Commission resolve the White Spaces Petitions for Reconsideration.¹ Specifically, we discussed the need to maintain the WMTS exclusion zones in Channel 37 and to replace the push notification requirement with fast-polling channels. We also thanked OET for its approval of Microsoft’s amended experimental license for the use of TVWS on school buses in Michigan.
