On April 5, 2019, Michel Combes, President and Chief Executive Officer, and Vonya McCann, Senior Vice President-Government Affairs of Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”), as well as Samuel L. Feder of Jenner & Block, Steven C. Sunshine of Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP, and the undersigned as outside counsel to Sprint, met with Matthew Berry, Federal Communications Commission Chief of Staff, to discuss the competitive and financial challenges Sprint faces as a standalone company and the public interest benefits of the proposed T-Mobile/Sprint merger.

Consistent with the Public Interest Statement¹ and Joint Opposition² filed in this proceeding, Sprint’s representatives discussed the financial, network, and scale challenges Sprint
