This letter serves as notice that on Monday, April 9, 2018 at 10:15 am local time at a room in N252-254 at the Las Vegas Convention Center, Messrs. Jordan Wertlieb, Nick Radziul, and Mark Prak met with Commissioner Michael O'Reilly and Brooke Ericson, at the invitation of the Commissioner, and discussed the current operation of the rules governing the provision of children's television programming.

Mr. Wertlieb and Mr. Radziul are the President and a Vice President, respectively, of Hearst Television, Inc. Mr. Prak is counsel to the company.

Mr. Wertlieb and Mr. Prak noted the importance of broadcasters' public service programming, including children's programming. They also noted that some improvements could be made to the existing rules to provide television stations with greater flexibility to deal with pre-emptions of such programming.
