I. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY

The Jicarilla Public Library serves is a tribal library serving the Jicarilla Apache Tribe in Northern New Mexico. The librarian is the only paid staff at the library. The librarian provides space and resources to students to complete their homework after school hours and provides public access computers to community members who lack broadband access at home.

The Wagon Mound Public Schools submitted and certified their Funding year 2019 FCC Form 471 191042060 utilizing the E-rate Productivity Center of the Schools and Libraries Division ("SLD") of the Universal Service Administrative Company's ("USAC") website, on April 10, 2019. The lack of a Category 2 application and lack internal networking to support a fiber connection was discovered during a site visit by the tribal librarian at the State Library, the state E-Rate

Coordinator at the Public Education Department, and the broadband coordinator from the state Department of Information Technology. We were able to obtain a valid quote that included installation and configuration from a vendor on the state master contract. Only one vendor was willing to travel to this remote part of the state and spend two working days to install and configure all the equipment.

II. Request

Jicarilla Public Library respectfully petitions the Commission to request a waiver of the Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471 filing deadline on behalf of the Wagon Mound Public Schools to allow the Out of Window submission of their E-Rate Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471 191042060 to allow E-Rate funding of the critical access to high speed Internet so the library is able to improve the service and access to the members of their community in this rural and isolated part of New Mexico.
