**COMMENTS ON PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

KRTY, Ltd. ("KRTY") (FRN 0006038954), licensee of Station KRTY(FM), Los Gatos, California (Fac. ID #35569), by its attorney, pursuant to Section 1.106(g) of the Commission's Rules, hereby comments on the April 5, 2018 "Petition for Reconsideration and Request for Reinstatement *Nunc Pro Tunc*" ("Petition") of SCA—PALO ALTO, LLC ("SCA"), which responded to the Commission's March 9, 2018 Letter dismissing SCA's subject application. The Petition purports to amend the application to "rectify...any interference concerns of KRTY" (Petition, p. 1).

1. KRTY appreciates SCA's stated desire to rectify KRTY's interference concerns through its amendment, and, therefore, KRTY does not oppose SCA's amendment. However, KRTY remains very concerned about actual interference that may be caused to KRTY's audiences in the event that SCA's translator station goes on the air; its amendment only deals with currently identified interference possibilities. In the event that actual interference arises at other locations once the station goes on air, KRTY will file a further documented objection. Since the likelihood of actual

interference in parts of KRTY's coverage area remains high, SCA may decide to forego building its proposed San Francisco FM translator station.

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, KRTY, Ltd. does not oppose the subject Petition, but it expresses great skepticism that the proposed amendment will cure all of KRTY's concerns and stands ready to file further objections if required once the translator station goes on the air.


