The Sterling Community School submitted and certified their Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471, #191015376, in the EPC portal of the Schools and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Administrative Company's ("USAC") website, on 04/11/2019 Form 471, just 15 days after the FCC Form 471 filing deadline of 03/27/2019.


