MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: July 1, 1992

Released: July 6, 1992

1. On May 15, 1992, Golden Corners Broadcasting, Inc. (GCBI) filed a Petition for Leave to Amend. At that time, GCBI wanted to amend its application to substitute a new corporation made up of GCBI and Clemson Broadcasting Inc. (CBI), called Three Lakes Broadcasting, Inc. Thus, the amendment if granted would have implemented a merger between GCBI and CBI.

Ruling

2. The Petition for Leave to Amend will be dismissed. Since May 15, 1992, the parties have changed their plans. They no longer plan to merge. Instead CBI has agreed to dismiss its application in return for reimbursement of a substantial portion of their reasonable and prudent prosecution expenses. GCBI would then be granted the Clemson construction permit. So this amendment is not needed.

SO the Petition for Leave to Amend that Golden Corners Broadcasting, Inc. filed on May 15, 1992, IS DISMISSED as moot; and the accompanying amendment IS REJECTED.
