Please pardon the delay.

This follows up on our call of March 28 regarding Adak and responds to your question about what the Company has been receiving under the Alaska Plan and what it expected to receive under an A-CAM second offer. Adak currently receives about \$350,000 per annum in USF support. It estimated that under an A-CAM second offer it would have received between \$792,000 and \$829,000 per annum, based on calculations of its cost consultant.

I will check back with you on matter of status of Petition For Reconsideration.
