Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 64.1120(e) of the Commission’s Rules,<sup>1</sup> Nicholville Telco LLC (“Nicholville Telco”) (FRN 0027271485), by its counsel, hereby respectfully notifies the Commission that Nicholville Telco intends to acquire the subscriber base of Nicholville Telephone Company, Inc. (“Nicholville”) (FRN 0004314480).<sup>2</sup>

In compliance with the requirements of Section 64.1120(e), Nicholville Telco provides the following information:

**Parties to the Transaction.**—The parties involved in this subscriber base transaction are Nicholville Telephone Company, Inc. (the Transferor), and Nicholville Telco LLC (the Transferee).

<sup>2</sup> Nicholville currently operates as a rural local exchange carrier (“RLEC”) in and around Nicholville, New York. As part of a pending acquisition and reorganization, Nicholville Telco, owned by Atlas Connectivity, LLC (“Atlas”), will receive Nicholville’s subscriber base (together with all its other assets), will replace Nicholville as the RLEC, and will operate in the same manner as Nicholville currently operates. Nicholville will be merged with and into SLIC Network Solutions, Inc., which is a competitive local exchange carrier currently operating as a wholly-owned subsidiary of Nicholville, and which will be owned by Atlas upon completion of the acquisition and reorganization.

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
**Types of Telecommunications Services Provided to Affected Subscribers.**—Local dial-tone telephone service, resold intrastate, interstate, international interexchange service, and Digital Subscriber Line service.

**Date of Transfer of Subscribers to Acquiring Carrier.**—Nicholville intends to transfer the affected subscribers to Nicholville Telco on May 21, 2018, or as soon thereafter as all necessary arrangements have been completed.

**Compliance Certification; Copy of Subscriber Notice.**—Attached to this letter are Nicholville Telco LLC's certification of compliance with requirements adopted by the Commission governing the transfer of subscribers (Exhibit A), and a copy of the notice to be sent to affected subscribers (Exhibit B). Notices will be mailed to subscribers on April 20, 2018.



## Important Notice Concerning Your Telephone Service

April 20, 2018

Dear Valued Customer:

Nicholville Telephone Company, Inc. ("Nicholville" or "Company") is pleased to announce that it has agreed to transfer its assets, including all of its customers, to Nicholville Telco LLC ("Nicholville Telco") as part of the reorganization of the Company to better help us run the business. We wanted you to know of this change since you are currently receiving one or more services from Nicholville, including local dial-tone telephone service, long distance service, and/or Digital Subscriber Line (DSL).

The anticipated effective date for this change of your telephone service provider is 5/21/2018, although the actual date could be later.

Please be assured that **this change will be transparent to all customers, your phone number will not be changed, and your telephone service and rates will not be affected.** In addition, the Company name will remain as Nicholville Telephone Company.

Here are additional details concerning the scheduled transfer of customers from Nicholville to Nicholville Telco:

### *Date of Transfer*

Pending required approvals from regulatory authorities, the parties expect that Nicholville Telco will begin service to transferred customers effective on or about 5/21/2018, although, as stated above, the date could be later.

### *Rates, Terms, and Conditions of Service*

All services previously received by you from Nicholville will continue without interruption. The Company's reorganization has been structured so that the transfer of customers will be virtually seamless. **Current rates, terms, and conditions of service will not be affected by this reorganization and will remain the same.** Any future change in rates, terms, or conditions of your service will be made, and notice will be provided to you, in accordance with any applicable regulatory requirements.

<i>Carrier Change Charges</i>	You will not be assessed any carrier change charges as a result of the transfer of customers from Nicholville to Nicholville Telco.
<i>Right to Select a New Service Provider</i>	You may choose another preferred carrier for your local dial-tone telephone service and for your long distance services, if an alternative carrier is available. Unless you elect to change to another preferred carrier, <b>no action is required by you, and you will continue to receive the same services from Nicholville Telco without interruption.</b>
<i>Carrier Freezes</i>	If you have any restriction or a “freeze” on your preferred local or long distance carrier (to prevent unauthorized changes in your carrier), that freeze will not be affected as part of the transfer of customers to Nicholville Telco. Should you desire to change the status of your freeze or have any questions, please contact our customer service representatives at the number listed below.
<i>Service Complaints</i>	Nicholville will be responsible for addressing any customer complaints regarding your local dial-tone telephone service, your long distance service, as well as your DSL service, if applicable, before the completion of the transfer of the customer base. Nicholville Telco will be responsible for any complaints you may have regarding any of these services after the transfer is complete.
