FCC Form 471 Filing Deadline for Funding Year 2019

I. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY

The Resilience Charter School is a public charter school within the Alachua County School District, serving students in grades 6 through 8 in Alachua County, Florida. Since 2016, Resilience Charter School has been a very small but successful participant of the E-Rate program.

Resilience Charter School submitted and certified their Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471, Application #191042142, in the “Apply Online” portal of the Schools and Libraries Division (“SLD”) of the Universal Service Administrative Company’s (“USAC”) website, on April 22, 2019, just 26 days after the FCC Form 471 filing deadline of March 27, 2019.

The director of Resilience Charter School works E-Rate into her already busy work schedule and is the sole staff member performing E-Rate duties. Because the former 2016 contract for Category 1 services was a 3-year contract, and didn't require a new Form 470 be filed until 2019, the earlier filing deadline for the Form 470 was missed in the director's busy schedule, as she was used to meeting only the Form 471 deadline required in 2017 and 2018.

II. Request

The Resilience Charter School respectfully petitions the Commission to request a waiver of the Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471 filing deadline on behalf of Resilience Charter School to allow the Out of Window submission of their E-Rate Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471, Application # 191042142, due to the oversight in the director's busy schedule and the limitations of the small staff size at Resilience Charter School.
