I oppose RM-11831.

I am an emergency response volunteer in my community. In the event of a natural disaster, we have a network of communication hubs that would be activated to support local neighborhoods. We rely on digital ham radio services to provide that connectivity. RM-11831 threatens the digital services we use.

Please do not regulate digital ham radio into oblivion. It is not clear to me what is broken about current digital operations, but RM-11831 would certainly break our ability to provide emergency services.

I cannot stress enough the important role digital ham radio plays in our ability to provide emergency communications.
