
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 26, 2018, James Goldstein, Senior Counsel, Legal and Government Affairs and the undersigned of Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”), met with Erin McGrath of Commissioner O’Rielly’s office, Will Adams of Commissioner Carr’s office, and Umair Javed of Commissioner Rosenworcel’s office. On April 27, 2018 the same parties met with Nicholas Degani and Rachael Bender, of Chairman Pai’s office.

At all the meetings, Sprint praised the Commission for placing the “Transforming the 2.5 GHz Band” Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on the May 10, 2018 Open Meeting Agenda. Sprint noted that the public will greatly benefit from expanding spectrum opportunities for existing EBS licensees as well as potential new EBS entrants. We further explained that adoption of new licensing opportunities for EBS licensees will further strengthen Sprint’s existing 4G LTE and future 5G deployments, benefitting customers as well as Sprint’s EBS partners. Sprint emphasized that, while it was still reviewing all the proposals in greater detail, it will work with the EBS community and the FCC on promoting a robust record in this long-awaited proceeding.

Pursuant to the Commission’s Rules, Sprint files this written notice in the docket in this proceeding.
