STATEMENT IN SUPPORT  
OF PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Manitou Broadcasting Corporation, licensee of Station WROI(FM), Rochester, IN. hereby expressly supports the Petition For Rule Making, originally filed by Dowagiac Broadcasting Company, Inc. on January 8, 1991, and expressly supports, also, the Petition For Reconsideration filed by Dowagiac Broadcasting Company, Inc. on May 31, 1991, both requesting amendment of §73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules to substitute Channel 229A for Channel 221A at Rochester, IN. and to modify the license of Station WROI(FM), Rochester, IN to provide for operation on Channel 229A. In support hereof, the following matters are set forth.

1. Since the filing of the above-referenced Petition for Rule Making and Petition for Reconsideration, principals and representatives of Manitou Broadcasting Corporation and Dowagiac Broadcasting Company, Inc. have had numerous



discussions concerning the benefits to each which would result from changing the operation of Station WROI(FM) to Channel 229A, and the procedures to be followed in providing for such a change in frequency.

2. As the result of such discussions, Manitou Broadcasting Corporation has now been supplied, and is satisfied with, the details of the manner in which Dowagiac Broadcasting Company, Inc. will pay or re-imburse Manitou Broadcasting Corporation for the costs involved in such a change in frequencies of Station WROI-FM.

3. Thus, Manitou Broadcasting Corporation does hereby support the above-referenced Petition for Rule Making and the Petition for Reconsideration; requests that the FCC promptly issue an appropriate Notice of Proposed Rule Making; certifies that if such a Notice is issued, that it will file Comments in support of substituting Channel 229A for Channel 221A at Rochester, IN. and the modification of WROI(FM)'s license to specify operation on Channel 229A; and, if granted, will, within 90 days thereafter file with the FCC the appropriate application (Form 301), requesting such a change in frequency and modification of the WROI(FM) license for Channel 229A.
