Dear Mr. Sanders:

This is in response to the petition for rule making which you submitted requesting the substitution of Channel 271C3 for Channel 271A and modification of the license for Station KJFM at Louisiana, Missouri. You further request the substitution of Channel 265C3 for Channel 272C3 at Canton, Missouri, to accommodate the upgrade at Louisiana.

We have reviewed your proposal and find that it is unacceptable for consideration as filed. A petition for rule making must include a distance separation study indicating that the proposed channel meets the minimum distance separation requirements of Section 73.207 of the Rules and a statement that the petitioner will apply for the channel, if allotted. The petitioner must sign and verify the petition in compliance with Section 1.52 of the Commission's Rules. Finally, the petitioner must file a signed original and four copies of the petition and serve the petition on any Commission permittee or licensee that would be affected by the proposal.

You failed to file a signed original and four copies. Furthermore, although you included a channel study for Channel 265C3 at Canton, Missouri, you did not provide a study for the allotment at Louisiana, Missouri. Finally, although you state that Bick Broadcasting, licensee of Station KBXB, Canton, does not object to the substitution at Canton, you did not file the letter of support from the president of Bick Broadcasting that you refer to in your petition. If a letter of consent from Bick Broadcasting is unavailable, you may provide a certificate of service showing that Station KBXB was served with a copy of the rule making petition.

Based on the above discussion, we are returning the proposal. You may refile the petition, provided that you correct these deficiencies.
