MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: July 10, 1992 Released: July 14, 1992

1. Jupiter Broadcasting Corp. (JBC) seeks a ruling on a Motion for Production of Documents that they filed on July 1, 1992. Their motion is directed at Robert B. Taylor and asks that he provide JBC with 2 categories of documents. Both categories relate to the maintenance of the WEXI/WTRU radio towers; i.e., the lighting and marking of those towers. Taylor opposed JBC's motion on July 8, 1992.

Ruling

2. JBC's motion will be granted. When an existing licensee claims a renewal expectancy, he must literally run on his entire record. That record embraces all facets of his operation, both technical and programming. So the documents that JBC requests are reasonably calculated to lead to the adduction of admissible evidence on the renewal expectancy question.

SO the Motion for Production of Documents that Jupiter Broadcasting Corp. filed on July 1, 1992, IS GRANTED; and Robert Taylor WILL MAKE the pertinent documents available for inspection and copying at the law offices of Leibowitz and Spencer, Amerifirst Building, One S.E. Third Avenue, Suite 1450, Miami, Florida 33131 within ten days of the release of this order.
