PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Communications Commission has designated for consolidated hearing the following applications for new FM stations in Central Florida: Central Florida Educational Foundation, Inc. (CFEF), Channel 202C3, Union Park, Florida; Bible Broadcasting Network, Inc. (BBN), Channel 202C2, Conway, Florida; Southwest Florida Community Radio, Inc., Channel 202C2, Conway, Florida; Miss Community Radio, Inc., Channel 202C1, Oak Hill, Florida; and Hispanic Broadcast System, Inc., Channel 202C3, Lake Mary, Florida.

The hearing will commence on July 21, 1992 at the offices of the Federal Communications Commission in Washington, D.C.

The issues as listed in the Hearing Designation Order are as follows:

1. If a final environmental impact statement is issued with respect to the above-mentioned applicants, in which it is concluded that the proposed facilities are likely to have an adverse effect on the quality of the environment, to determine whether the proposal is consistent with the National Environmental Policy Act, as implemented by Section 1.1301-1.1310 of the Commission's rules.
2. To determine: (a) the number of other reserved channel non-commercial educational FM services available in the proposed service area of each applicant, and the area and population served thereby; (b) whether a share-time arrangement between the applicants would result in the most effective use of the channel, and thus better serve the public interest and, if so, the terms and conditions thereof; and, (c) in light of Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, which of the proposals would best provide a fair, efficient, and equitable distribution of radio service.
3. To determine, in the event it is concluded that a choice between the application should not be based solely on considerations relating to Section 307(b), the extent to which each of the proposed operations will be integrated in the overall cultural and educational objectives of the respective applicants; and whether other factors in the record demonstrate that one applicant will provide a superior FM educational broadcast service.
4. To determine, in light of the evidence adduced pursuant to the specified issues, which of the applicants should be granted, if any.
