This is in further response to letters dated February 25 and 27, 1991, from Dennis Williams, Chief, FM Branch to He's Alive, Inc. Most recently, in a letter dated April 29, 1991, He's Alive stated that it was evaluating the situation to determine what steps could be taken to conform with the basic requirements of Section 73.525 of the Commission's rules. In fact, He's Alive, Inc. has located a new transmitter location and is in the process of amending its application. That amendment will contain a revised TV 6 interference study which is expected to demonstrate compliance with Section 73.525 of the rules. However, in order to ensure that amendment's accuracy, He's Alive is having its engineering reviewed by another team of engineering consultants

In view of the above, He's Alive, Inc. requests an additional two weeks until and including Monday, May 20, 1991 to file an amendment responsive to the Commission's February 25 and 27, 1991 letter directives.
