Dear Ms. Searcy:

This is in response to letters dated February 25 and 27, 1991 from Dennis Williams, Chief, FM Branch to He's Alive Incorporated, applicant for a new educational non-commercial station at Murrysville, Pennsylvania. The February 25, 1991 letter addresses He's Alive's TV Channel 6 interference study done pursuant to Section 73.525 of the rules. On Monday, May 20, 1991, He's Alive filed an amendment to its application, involving the relocation to a new transmitter site. That amendment contains the required TV-6 interference showing which demonstrates that, from its site, He's Alive's proposed FM station will operate in compliance with Section 73.535 of the rules.

With respect to the Commission's directive contained in its February 27, 1991 letter that He's Alive and WRCT Radio (File No. BPED-891108MA) attempt to work out a settlement, the Commission is hereby apprised that He's Alive has explored settlement options with WRCT. He's Alive is willing to continue to explore the possibility of taking steps to remove any current mutual exclusivity with the assistance of WRCT.
