

**INITIAL SETTLEMENT STATUS REPORT**

Southwestern Ohio Seniors' Services, Inc. (SOSSI), by its attorneys, hereby respectfully submits the initial status report concerning settlement negotiations between it and Miami University. In that regard, the following is respectfully submitted:

1. Since the July 7, 1992, request to hold the procedural dates in abeyance, the attorneys for SOSSI and Miami University (Miami) have conducted one face-to-face settlement meeting, several telephone conferences, and have prepared and exchanged an initial draft of the written settlement agreement between the parties. As of this date the agreement has not been finalized, but the parties believe they have reached an agreement in principle to all substantial terms and are now in the process revising the initially drafted settlement document to conform to the agreement in principle.

2. The salient terms of the agreement will be as follows: (i) the request by Miami for the dismissal of its application; (ii) the amendment of SOSSI's application to specify the engineering proposal hitherto contained in Miami's application, (iii) the reimbursement to Miami by SOSSI -- subject to the Commission's approval -- of Miami's


reasonable and prudent expenses incurred in the preparation and prosecution of its application (including the negotiation of the settlement agreement) not to exceed \$25,000; and (iv) SOSSI's reimbursement payment to Miami to be subject to the grant of SOSSI's application, as amended.

3. A revision of the drafted settlement agreement is in preparation, and should be circulated by the close of business on July 21, 1992. It is reasonably possible -- subject to timely review of the revisions by the requisite officials at both SOSSI and Miami -- that the agreement could be consummated by month's end.

4. In order to provide the Presiding Administrative Law Judge with continuing information regarding the status of the settlement negotiations between the parties, the undersigned hereby undertakes to provide another status report by not later than Monday, August 3, 1992, unless the Settlement Agreement and a joint request for approval of the agreement are filed by that time.
