MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: July 21, 1992; Released: July 23, 1992

1. Under consideration are Motion to Compel Production of Documents from Healdsburg Empire Corporation, filed July 16, 1992 by Deas Communications, Inc.; Motion to Compel Production of Documents from Healdsburg Broadcasting, Inc., filed July 15, 1992 by Deas Communications, Inc.; and Motion to Compel filed July 16, 1992 by Healdsburg Broadcasting, Inc.

2. Deas' requests to Empire and HBI and HBI's request to Deas for compliance with the standard document production were considered at the prehearing. Empire should produce to counsel the documents requested by July 24, 1992 or sanctions will be imposed which will exclude Empire's integration proposal. HBI has until July 27, 1992 to produce the balance sheet. Deas need produce only the basic lending letter to HBI.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that the motion to compel production of documents from Healdsburg Empire Corporation, filed July 16, 1992 by Deas Communications, Inc. IS GRANTED to the extent indicated at the prehearing.


