MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: July 27, 1992 Released: July 29, 1992

1. Jupiter Broadcasting Corporation (JBC) seeks a ruling on a "Motion for Production of Documents." That motion is directed at Robert B. Taylor, was filed on July 1, 1992, and asks for 2 categories of documents. Both categories relate to the compliance or noncompliance with tower marking and lighting requirements during the WTRU license renewal period. Taylor opposed on July 8, 1992.
