**APPLICATION OF COMPATEL, LLC FOR AUTHORIZATION TO OBTAIN  
NUMBERING RESOURCES**

Compatel, LLC ("Compatel"), pursuant to Section 52.15(g)(3)(i) of the Commission's Rules, requests the authorization to obtain the numbering resources as described below. Compatel requests the Commission to grant its authorization as set forth in the Commission's Numbering and Policies for the Modern Communications, FCC 15-70 (June 22, 2015) in order to obtain the numbering resources from the North American Numbering Administrator. As an evidence supporting the application Compatel hereby provides the following information:

I. INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 52.15(g)(3)(i)

(A) § 52.15(g)(3)(i)(A)

(B) § 52.15(g)(3)(i)(B)

Compatel hereby acknowledges that the authorization to obtain the numbering resources under section 52.15(g) of the Commission's Rules is subject to compliance with the applicable Commission numbering rules as well as with the relevant authority in each state. Compatel hereby also acknowledges that mentioned authorization is subject to the compliance with all industry guidelines and practices in regards with numbering. The numbering resources that are the subject of this Application will be used to provide interconnected VoIP services initially in New York.

(C) § 52.15(g)(3)(i)(C)

Compatel acknowledges that it must file the request for the numbers' range with the relevant state commission(s) at least 30 days before requesting the numbers' range from the Numbering Administrators.

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(D) § 52.15(g)(3)(i)(D)

Compatel hereby sets forth its capability to provide the service within 60 days of date the numbering resources will be activated. Compatel has executed a commercial agreement with a competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC") to route traffic to the incumbent carriers. Compatel has been acquiring numbers through other carriers. Having proper number resources will allow us to better deliver services and reliability to our retail and wholesale customers. As evidence supporting its facilities readiness, Compatel attaches to this application:

1. Exhibit A; An agreement between Compatel and its carrier partner providing that the carrier partner will host Compatel numbers on its switches and provide PSTN connectivity for inbound calls to Compatel numbers
2. Exhibit B; The Interconnection agreement between Compatel's carrier partner and an Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier.

Compatel has requested confidential treatment under the Commission's rules for both Exhibits and has filed them separately.

(E) § 52.15(g)(3)(i)(E)

Compatel certifies that it complies with its Universal Service Fund contribution obligations under 47 CFR part 54, subpart H, its Telecommunications Relay Service contribution obligations under 47 CFR § 64.604(5)(iii), its North American Numbering Plan and Local Number Portability Administration contribution obligations under 47 CFR §§ 52.17 and 52.32, its obligation to pay regulatory fees under 47 CFR § 1.1154, and its 911 obligations under 47 CFR part 9.

(F) § 52.15(g)(3)(i)(F)

Compatel certifies that it has the financial, managerial and technical expertise to provide reliable service. It is financially stable, is led by a strong and experienced team of individuals with substantial managerial experience in the telecommunications industry. It also has sufficient technical expertise and infrastructure in place to provide reliable numbering services. Compatel has successfully operated its communications business since 2010. Compatel key management personnel are listed below.
