
**CERTIFICATION OF PUERTO RICO TELEPHONE COMPANY, INC.**

As of April 3, 2018,

- 1) PRTC does not provide service or report live call data in one or more of the Test Cities;
- 2) PRTC is providing dispatchable location or x/y location information within 50 meters for 50 percent of all wireless 911 calls;
- 3) PRTC has deployed the indoor location technology or technologies used in its networks consistent with the manner in which such technologies have been tested in the test bed; and
- 4) PRTC has verified based on its own live call data that it is in compliance with the three-year benchmark set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 20.18(i)(2)(i)(B)(2).

PRTC represents and warrants that the above certification is consistent with 47 C.F.R. § 1.17 which requires truthful and accurate statements to the Commission.
