Description of Network Changes Planned:

On March 3, 2019, an F4-rated tornado hit parts of Lee County, including parts of the Phenix City Main wire center (PHCYALMA, 1600 Opelika Rd, Phenix City, AL), in eastern Alabama and destroyed homes, electrical lines, and a cell tower among other things. In response to Alabama Governor Kay Ivey's March 4th request, President Donald Trump approved a Major Disaster Declaration for Lee County on March 5th triggering the release of federal funds to help people and communities recover from the severe storms, straight-line winds, and tornadoes.

AT&T Alabama personnel surveyed the devastated area to determine the impact to the network, and that analysis revealed numerous facilities irreparably damaged, including a copper cable cross-connect box and aerial fiber and copper cables, as well as the corresponding utility poles. As a result of the tornado damage, almost all existing aerial facilities must be rebuilt by their owners- the power company, various CATV providers, and AT&T Alabama.

After field assessment of impacted DA 150501, AT&T Alabama determined that certain copper distribution cables serving affected customers within the DA were irreparable and must be replaced. An existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) system serving a nearby DA will be expanded, coupled with the installation of new fiber distribution cable, to serve the homes previously served by the damaged copper facilities.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

As a result of this damage and the subsequent AT&T Alabama decision, these damaged copper distribution cables in DA150501 will no longer be available. Since all impacted addresses will be served with GPON/FTTP, unbundled loops requiring copper facilities, e.g.,

digital subscriber line (DSL) or line-sharing circuits, will no longer be available in this DA. Currently, AT&T has no record of any competitive carrier circuits assigned over copper facilities in DA150501.
