I. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY

Westchester Public School District 92½ (“Westchester Public Schools”) serves low income pre-kindergarten through Grade 8 children in Cook County, Illinois. Since 2012, Westchester Public Schools has been a very small but successful participant of the E-Rate program.

Westchester Public Schools submitted and certified their Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471, Application Number 191042303, in the “Apply Online” portal of the Schools and Libraries Division (“SLD”) of the Universal Service Administrative Company’s (“USAC”) website, on May 9, 2019, just 43 days after the FCC Form 471 filing deadline of March 27, 2019.

A staff member of Westchester Public Schools works E-Rate into his already busy work schedule, and is the sole staff member performing E-Rate duties. Due to a catastrophic illness

in the family, the staff member did not file the E-Rate 471 by the established deadline. The unfiled application was noticed upon review of the program and filed immediately.

II. Request

Westchester Public Schools respectfully petitions the Commission to request a waiver of the Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471 filing deadline on behalf of the Westchester Public School District 92½ to allow the Out of Window submission of their E-Rate Funding Year 2019 FCC Form 471 #191042303, due to catastrophic illness..
