On May 9, 2018, representatives of the six conditionally-approved Spectrum Access System (SAS) Administrators (Amdocs, CommScope, Federated Wireless, Google, Key Bridge, and Sony) met with staff from the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and the Office of Engineering and Technology, as well as with representatives of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration and the Department of Defense, for a preliminary discussion regarding SAS field testing. A list of FCC and industry attendees is attached to this letter.

The SAS Administrators discussed methods by which field trials might be conducted. The SAS Administrators also underscored the importance of achieving, as expeditiously as possible, commercial SAS service within the Commission's existing framework for SAS certification.
