On May 9, 2018, I spoke with Martha Heller of the Media Bureau regarding the above-captioned proceedings. In particular, I discussed the issue of how, as part of its ongoing efforts to “eliminate or modify regulations that are outdated, unnecessary or unduly burdensome,”<sup>1</sup> the Commission could take steps to reduce the burdens imposed on cable operators by the existing leased access rules,<sup>2</sup> in particular by reexamining the requirement for cable operators to lease time on a part-time basis.
