Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), notice is hereby provided of an oral *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced docket. On May 9, 2019, David Miller, General Counsel of T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), Kathleen Ham, Senior Vice President, Government Affairs of T-Mobile, Vonya McCann, Senior Vice President-Government Affairs of Sprint Corporation ("Sprint," and collectively with T-Mobile, "Applicants"), and other representatives of the Applicants¹ met with Matthew Berry, FCC Chief of Staff, Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology, and members of the T-Mobile/Sprint Transaction Team identified in Attachment A. During the meeting, the representatives of the Applicants reviewed in detail the New T-Mobile 5G network build plan, as described in their network model and various filings previously submitted in this docket. In particular, the representatives discussed the planned low-band and mid-band 5G network coverage, the pace and depth of such deployment, and the resulting speeds likely to be experienced by consumers using 5G devices. The representatives also discussed New T-Mobile's incentives to complete the 5G network build as proposed.
