On May 11, 2018, Rebecca Murphy Thompson of Competitive Carriers Association; Scott Bergmann of CTIA; Michael Fitzpatrick of General Electric Company; Danielle Piñeres of NCTA-The Internet & Television Association; Jill Canfield of NTCA-The Rural Broadband Association; Erin Fitzgerald on behalf of the Rural Wireless Association, Inc.; and Claude Aiken of the Wireless Internet Service Providers Association met with Commissioner Michael O’Rielly and Erin McGrath to further discuss the above-captioned proceeding.¹
