On May 16, 2018, Paul Jamieson of Altice USA, Inc. ("Altice USA" or the "Company") and Justin Lilley of TeleMedia Policy Corp., representing Altice USA, met separately with Jay Schwarz, Amy Bender, Jamie Susskind, and Travis Litman, Wireline Advisors to Chairman Pai and Commissioners O'Rielly, Carr, and Rosenworcel, respectively, to discuss the above-referenced proceedings.

During these meetings, Altice USA provided an update on the Company's broadband network investment initiatives, including its construction of a Fiber to the Home ("FTTH") network and its siting of wireless equipment. Specifically, the Company discussed the processes it has encountered for obtaining permits to site FTTH facilities and the positions of certain municipalities with respect to authorizations for wireless equipment. The Company also discussed measures the Commission could take to accelerate Altice USA's broadband investment in the above-referenced proceedings.
