Pursuant to the *Wireline Broadband Order*¹, Citizens Mutual Telephone (CMT), files the enclosed notice of its intent to discontinue its wireline broadband access service offering under NECA Tariff No. 5 effective July 2, 2019. CMT will provide Digital Subscriber Line Service on a de-tariffed common carrier basis effective July 2, 2019.

CMT has notified its current affected customers per the attached memo dated May 15, 2019. The geographic area CMT serves is the town of Bloomfield, Iowa as well as its other nearby exchanges within its own telephone exchange. There will be no significant change to its customers with CMT's choice to de-tariff its DSL services as the provisioning of this service will not be affected by this decision. Effective July 2, 2019, the terms and conditions under which DSL will be offered by CMT will be posted for public inspection on its website at www.mycmtech.com and a physical copy of the offerings will be available at its office, located at 114W Jefferson St, Bloomfield, IA 52537.

This is an informational notice as required by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), *no action is necessary on your part*, that Citizens Mutual Telephone (CMT) will discontinue providing Digital Subscriber Line Access Service on a tariffed basis. Effective July 2, 2019, CMT will no longer participate in NECA Tariff No. 5, for Digital Subscriber Line Access Service and instead will offer the service on a de-tariffed Title II Common Carrier basis.

CMT serves the town of Bloomfield, Iowa and its other exchanges within CMT's study area boundary. The provisioning of services for your current Digital Subscriber Line Access Service and Consumer Broadband Only Loop Service is not changing. 
