**SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF
Camden Telephone and Telegraph Company, Inc.**

Camden Telephone and Telegraph Company, Inc. ("Applicant") seeks authorization pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214(a) and Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue its switched access tandem exchange services to the St. Mary's, Georgia market area.

The Applicant provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules:

1. Name and Address of the Carrier: Camden Telephone and Telegraph Company, Inc., 525 Junction Road, Madison, Wisconsin 53717.
2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance: Applicant plans to discontinue the affected services on July 30, 2018.
3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Applicant proposes to discontinue the affected services in St. Mary's, Georgia.
4. Description of Service Affected: Switched access tandem exchange services provide the ability to originate calls from an end user's premises to a customer's premises, and to terminate calls from a customer's premises to an end user's premises.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: Applicant does not have any customers utilizing this service.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier: Applicant is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

7. Other Information: In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, a copy of this application is being mailed concurrently with its filing to the Governor of Georgia, the Georgia Public Utilities Commission and the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense.
