Dear Mr. Costello:

This is in response to your letter requesting the substitution of Channel 292C3 for Channel 292A at Thibodaux, Louisiana.

Although you provided a map showing the area in which a transmitter can be located, you failed to provide a set of geographic coordinates and a technical study demonstrating compliance with the domestic and foreign minimum distance separation requirements of Section 73.207(b) (1) and (3) of the Commission's Rules. Moreover, we find that your proposal does not comply with Section 1.52 of the Commission's Rules, which requires that a petitioner, unless represented by legal counsel, sign and verify all pleadings submitted to the Commission. While you provided a signed original of your proposal, you did not include an affidavit verifying that the statements contained in your proposal are accurate to the best of your knowledge. Finally, you also failed to state an intention to apply for Channel 292C3, if allotted to Thibodaux, as required by Commission policy.

Based on the above, we are returning your proposal. You may refile this proposal, provided you correct these deficiencies.
