On May 15, 2019, Intel Corporation, represented by Sandra Rivera, Senior Vice President of Network Platforms Group, Asha Keddy, Vice President of Next Generation Standards Group, Jayne Stancavage, Executive Director of Communications Policy in the Government, Markets, and Trade Group, and Reza Arefi, Director of Spectrum Strategy in the Next Generation Standards Group, met with Commissioner Rosenworcel and Jessica Martinez. Intel discussed the importance of 5G and the associated significance of mid-band spectrum. In particular, Intel encouraged the expeditious completion of rules to enable licensed terrestrial mobile use of the 3.7-4.2 GHz band and unlicensed shared use of the 5.925-7.125 GHz band.
