On May 16, 2019, on behalf of ViSalus, Inc. (“ViSalus”), Jennifer Tatel and the undersigned of Wilkinson Barker Knauer, LLP met with Mark Stone, Kurt Schroder, and Nancy Stevenson of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau.
