MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: August 4, 1992; Released: August 6, 1992

1. Jupiter Broadcasting Corp. (JBC) and Robert B. Taylor (Taylor) seek a ruling on a "Joint Motion for Extension of Time." They want the date for extending the preliminary engineering extended to August 14, 1992. The only other party to the proceeding, the Mass Media Bureau has indicated that they will not object to the requested extension.

Ruling

2. The Joint Motion will be granted. Extending the preliminary engineering date to August 14, 1992 should not unduly impact on the future procedural schedule.

SO the "Joint Motion for Extension of Time" that Jupiter Broadcasting Corp. and Robert B. Taylor filed on August 3, 1992, IS GRANTED; and the time for exchanging the preliminary engineering IS CONTINUED until August 14, 1992.
