
***Re: Ex Parte Meeting, WC Docket No. 18-213, Promoting Telehealth for

On May 16, 2019, the undersigned and Pete November, Executive Vice President and Chief Administrative Officer of Ochsner Health System, David Houghton, M.D. Medical Director, Telemedicine and Chief of the Division of Movement & Memory Disorders and Vice-Chair of the Department of Neurology, April Radford, Vice President Telemedicine, Ochsner Health System, Leonardo Seoane, M.D. Senior Vice President and Chief Academic Officer Ochsner Medical Center, Ilisa Paul, President of the District Policy Group at Drinker Biddle & Reath, met with Preston Wise, Special Counsel to FCC Chairman Ajit Pai.
