COMMENTS

Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc. (“Nexstar”), licensee of full power, non-repack, television station WNLO(TV), Buffalo, New York (Fac. ID 71905) (“WNLO”), hereby submits its Comments¹ in the above-captioned proceeding. In response to a Petition for Rule Making filed by Nexstar on December 12, 2018 (the “Petition”),² the Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rule Making³ proposing to change WNLO’s DTV Channel 32 to DTV Channel 36 at Buffalo, New York.⁴ Nexstar hereby reaffirms its interest in the proposed channel substitution. As outlined in the Petition, the channel substitution will serve the public interest

because it would allow for a more efficient allocation of UHF television channels and will resolve significant over-the-air reception problems in WIVB's⁵ prior service area.

If the proposal set forth is adopted, Nexstar will promptly file the appropriate applications to specify operation of WNLO on DTV Channel 36 at Buffalo, New York with facilities consistent with those specified in the Petition and, if authorized, will construct the facilities contemplated therein and place the station into operation. As set forth in the Petition, the channel substitution can be accomplished in complete conformity with all Commission allocation requirements
