PETITION FOR RULEMAKING

One Ministries, Inc. ("OMI" or "Petitioner"), licensee of noncommercial educational FM broadcast station KORB (FM), Hopland, CA, as well as KQSL (DT), Fort Bragg, CA, by its counsel, hereby submits this Petition for Rule Making to amend the Digital Television Table of Allotments to add a new noncommercial educational DTV allotment on Channel *6 at Lakeport, CA in order to provide a new education broadcast service to the public that will cover significant gray area and provide significant first educational area service to the proposed service area. Specifically, Petitioner requests that the Commission amend the DTV Table of Allotments as stated in the following proposal.

1. The proposal is as follows:

2. Section 73.622(a) of the Commission's Rules states in part:

Where there is only one technically available channel available in a community, an entity that would be eligible to operate a noncommercial

educational broadcast station may, prior to application, initiate a rulemaking proceeding requesting that an unoccupied or new channel in the community be changed or added as reserved only for noncommercial educational broadcasting upon demonstrating that the noncommercial educational proponent would provide a first or second noncommercial educational TV service to 2,000 or more people who constitute 10% of the population within the proposed allocation's noise limited contour.

3. As licensee of noncommercial educational FM station KORB, OMI is eligible to operate and is indeed operating a noncommercial educational broadcasting station. The proposed new educational DTV station would provide a new television service to 902,162 people and a first or second noncommercial educational TV service to 143,813 people who constitute 10% or more (15.9% by calculation) of the population within the proposed allocation's noise limited contour as detailed in the attached Engineering Statement of Keith Leitch (Attachment A hereto at Section 8).


4. Also attached as Exhibit B is a Demographic Statement relating to Lakeport and the proposed service area. As set forth therein, it is well demonstrated that the proposed new noncommercial educational DTV station will provide much needed new educational service to the proposed service area. Accordingly, grant of the instant petition for rule making would serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

WHEREFORE THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, it is respectfully requested that the Commission amend the Digital Television Table of Allotments as proposed hereinabove.
