ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR REPLY COMMENTS

Adopted: October 24, 1991

By the Office of Engineering and Technology:

1. On October 23, 1991, TRW Inc. (TRW) requested that the time for filing reply comments in the above-captioned proceeding be extended from October 31, 1991 to November 14, 1991.

2. In its request, TRW states that the comments filed in this proceeding involve highly technical matters which it will need to evaluate before it can offer useful comments to the Commission. TRW also states that some of the pleadings filed involved very complex allocations issues that can not be properly evaluated in the remaining 14 days of the reply comment period.

3. The Commission does not routinely grant extensions of time. However, we concur with TRW that in this instance an extension of time is warranted to permit all parties to fully analyze the comments on the complex technical matters that are at issue in this proceeding. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, that the deadline for filing reply comments in this proceeding IS EXTENDED to November 14, 1991.

4. This action is taken pursuant to authority found in Section 4(i), 302, and 303 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Sections 154(i), 302, and 303, and pursuant to Sections 0.31 and 0.241 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Sections 0.31 and 0.241.
