On May 22, 2018, David E. Weisman, President and Chief Executive Officer of InSite Wireless Group, LLC, met with Commissioner Michael O'Rielly and Erin McGrath, his Legal Advisor, while all were present at the WIA's Connect (X) Connectivity Expo in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Mr. Weisman discussed issues involving the likely impact upon communities and residences if the FCC were to preempt local zoning ordinances pertaining to the deployment of wireless infrastructure (including towers, DAS, and small cells) outside of the public right-of-way. The discussion also included the principles of collocation and the impact that such preemption would have on business.
