MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: August 6, 1992; Released: August 7, 1992


1. Robert B. Taylor (Taylor) seeks a ruling on a "Motion for Extension of Time." He filed his motion on August 5, 1992, and wants the time for filing an Opposition to Jupiter Broadcasting Corp. (JBC) Second Petition to Enlarge Issues extended from August 6, 1992 to August 12, 1992 (4 working days). JBC consents to a grant of the extension.

Ruling

2. Taylor will be accommodated this once, and the Motion granted. Although this will delay the filing of JBC's reply, if enlargement becomes necessary we should still be able to fit everything into the Phase II time schedule. See FCC 92M-765 released July 10, 1992.

SO the Motion for Extension of Time that Robert B. Taylor filed on August 5, 1992, IS GRANTED, and Taylor WILL HAVE until August 12, 1992 to file a response to JBC's Second Petition to Enlarge Issues.
