Dear Chairman Sikes:


I have reviewed the contents of CC Docket No. 92-77 and find that this proposed rule would not best serve the public interest. It would, in my opinion, serve to dismantle an arrangement my company shares with Communications Central Inc. ("CCI"), a competitive payphone provider, and destroy future competition.

The payphones installed by CCI allow consumers to reach their carrier of choice simply by dialing a carrier access code, with the guarantee that access will not be blocked. Allowing the local telephone companies bottleneck control over the initiation and routing of 0+ calls will enable them to reclaim their monopoly over payphones and operator services and would burden rate payers with unnecessary costs.

We believe the current system affords our consumers access to their preferred carrier and enables our company to maintain quality payphone service to our patrons. Implementing billed party preference would severely threaten this public interest goal.


Mr. Chairman,
