

In a Hearing Designation Order DA 92-577 released May 20, 1992, the Federal Communications Commission designated for comparative hearing the applications of DEAS COMMUNICATIONS, INC., DRAGONFLY COMMUNICATIONS, INC., HEALDSBURG BROADCASTING, INC., BECKWITH COMMUNICATIONS, INC., DESERT ROCK LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, HEALDSBURG EMPRIE CORPORATION for a construction permit for a new FM station on channel 240A in Healdsburg, CA. A hearing has been set for October 5, 1992, at 10:00 am, in Washington, D.C. The issues specified for hearing are as follows:

- 1.) To determine whether Beckwith is owned or controlled by aliens or their representatives, in violation of Section 310(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.
- 2.) If a final environmental impact statement is issued with respect to HBI, Dragonfly, Beckwith, Desert Rock and Empire in which it is concluded that the proposed facilities are likely to have an adverse effect on the quality of the environment to determine whether the proposals are consistent with the National Environmental Policy Act, as implemented by 47 C.F.R. Sections 1.1301-1319.

3.) To determine which of the proposals would, on a comparative basis, best serve the public interest.

4.) To determine, in light of the evidence adduced pursuant to the specified issues, which of the applications should be granted, if any.

A copy of the Healdsburg Broadcasting, Inc.'s application, amendments and related material are on file for public inspection at Healdsburg Public Library in Healdsburg, California.


