Dear Mr. Stone:

This is in response to your request for a refund of the hearing fee submitted by Orchon Broadcasting Company (Orchon), successful applicant for a new FM station at Greenville, Georgia.

Orchon timely paid its hearing fee and its application was subsequently designated for a comparative hearing to select the licensee at Greenville. The Hearing Designation Order specified a contingent environmental issue against Orchon. However, prior to the time for filing Notices of Appearance, the competing applicants filed a settlement agreement. The presiding Administrative Law Judge approved the settlement agreement, granted the license to Orchon, and deleted the environmental issue. See Nadine P. Richardson, MM Docket No. 92-63, released June 2, 1992.

Section 1.1111(c)(4) of the Commission's rules provide that a hearing fee will be refunded whenever a settlement agreement entered by the parties to a comparative proceeding is submitted prior to the time for filing Notices of Appearance and any outstanding issue designated against the surviving applicant is resolved without the need for a decision on the merits. In the instant case, the ALJ deleted Orchon's outstanding environmental issue and, therefore, Orchon is entitled to a refund.

Accordingly, your request is granted. A check, drawn in the amount of \$6,760.00 and made payable to Orchon Broadcasting Company, will be sent to you at the earliest practicable time. If you have any questions concerning this refund, please contact the Chief, Fee Section at (202) 632-0241.

APPLICATION FOR REFUND OF HEARING FEE

Orchon Broadcasting Company ("Orchon")¹, by counsel, hereby respectfully submits its Application for Refund of Hearing Fee paid by Orchon on July 10, 1991, prior to the designation of its above-captioned application for comparative hearing. In support whereof, the following is respectfully shown:

1. By *Public Notice*, Report NA-143, released March 11, 1991, the Commission announced the acceptance for filing of Orchon's application. Thereafter, the Commission announced its determination that comparative applicants for broadcast facilities would be required to pay hearing fees prior to designation for comparative hearing. *Proposals to Reform the Commission's Comparative Hearing Process to Expedite the Resolution of Cases*, 6 FCC Rcd. 157, 158, *recon. granted in part*, 6 FCC Rcd. 3403 (1991) ("*Hearing Reform Order*"). Because Orchon's application had already been accepted for filing in a public notice released prior to the

effective date of the *Hearing Reform Order* (July 1, 1991), the Commission announced that Orchon's hearing fee would be due on or before July 15, 1991. 6 FCC Rcd. at 3403. As noted above, Orchon timely submitted its hearing fee (See *Exhibit A*).

2. On April 13, 1992, Orchon's application was designated for comparative hearing by the Chief, Audio Services Division. *Nadine P. Richardson, d/b/a Rocky Mount Broadcasting*, 7 FCC Rcd. 2297 (MMB 1992) ("*HDO*"). Therein, a contingent environmental issue was specified against Orchon, subject to deletion upon the submission of an environmental assessment which satisfied the requirements of § 1.1311 of the Commission's rules. On April 30, 1992, Orchon submitted its environmental assessment in the form of a petition for leave to amend, which was found acceptable by the Audio Services Division. By *Order*, FCC 92M-604, released May 27, 1992, Chief Administrative Law Judge Joseph Stirmer accepted Orchon's April 30, 1992 amendment and deleted the contingent environmental issue which had been specified against Orchon.

3. On April 30, 1992, Orchon and competing applicant Nadine P. Richardson, d/b/a Rocky Mount Broadcasting ("*Richardson*") filed a Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement, contemplating the dismissal of Richardson's application and the grant of Orchon's application. By *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, FCC 92M-633, released June 2, 1992, Judge Stirmer granted the Joint Motion filed by Richardson and Orchon, dismissed Richardson's application, and granted Orchon's application, noting that the contingent environmental issue previously specified against Orchon had been deleted (See *Exhibit B*). It should be noted that the Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement was filed prior to the Notice of Appearance deadline (May 4, 1992) established by § 1.221 of the Commission's rules.

4. In light of the above, Orchon respectfully submits that it is entitled to a refund, in full, of its hearing fee in the amount of Six Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars

(\$6,760.00), pursuant to the provisions of § 1.1111(b)(4) of the Commission's rules. *See, also, Establishment of a Fee Collection Program to Implement the Provisions of the Omnibus Reconciliation Act of 1989 (Memorandum Opinion and Order)*, 6 FCC Rcd. 5919, 5925 (1991). Orchon's Settlement Agreement was filed with the Presiding Judge by the Notice of Appearance deadline, which Settlement Agreement provided for the dismissal of all but Orchon's application. Because the contingent environmental issue could be and was deleted, Orchon's application was immediately grantable, thereby allowing for a full refund of Orchon's hearing fee.





MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: June 1, 1992

FCC MAIL BRANCH

1. Under consideration are a "Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement" filed by Orchon Broadcasting Company (Orchon) and Nadine P. Richardson d/b/a Rocky Mount Broadcasting (Richardson) on April 30, 1992; "Supplement to Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement" filed by Richardson on May 4, 1992; "Further Supplement to Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement" filed by Richardson on May 8, 1992; and "Mass Media Bureau's Comments on Joint Motion for Approval of Agreement" filed by the Bureau on May 14, 1992.

2. Orchon and Richardson have entered into an agreement to resolve this proceeding and have submitted such agreement for approval. Pursuant thereto, Richardson has agreed to dismiss her application in consideration of the payment by Orchon of \$16,860.90. The dismissal of the Richardson application will moot the comparative issue. Because there are no basic issues outstanding with respect to Orchon, its application may be immediately granted.¹

3. The applicants have complied with the requirements of Sections 73.3525(a)(1) and (a)(2) of the Commission's rules, and Section 311(c)(3) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Specifically, a copy of the


settlement agreement has been filed, both applicants have demonstrated that approval of the settlement agreement would serve the public interest, and that neither application was filed for the purpose of reaching or carrying out a settlement agreement. Moreover, it has been established that the \$16,860.90 to be paid to Richardson is not in excess of legitimate and prudent expenses. Thus, approval of the agreement will serve the public interest.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the "Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement" filed by Orchon Broadcasting Company and Nadine P. Richardson d/b/a Rocky Mount Broadcasting on April 30, 1992, IS GRANTED; the agreement IS APPROVED; payment in the amount of \$16,860.90 IS AUTHORIZED; the application of Nadine P. Richardson d/b/a Rocky Mount Broadcasting (File No. BPH-901221MG) IS DISMISSED, with prejudice; the application of Orchon Broadcasting Company, Inc.
