

DECLARATION OF JOHN C. SAW

I, John C. Saw, do hereby, under penalty of perjury, declare and state as follows:

1. In accordance with Section 20.18 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission (47 C.F.R. § 20.18), I certify the compliance of Sprint Corporation ("Sprint") with the 9-1-1 location accuracy requirements applicable as of April 3, 2018.
2. Sprint has complied with the test bed and live call data provisions described in paragraph (i)(3) of Section 20.18 of the Commission's rules.
