Dear Mr. Stockdale and Ms. Harris,

The Michigan Department of Attorney General ("Attorney General") is conducting an inquiry into the proposed acquisition of Sprint Corporation by T-Mobile US, Inc. to determine whether it would violate any federal and/or Michigan laws. In connection with this investigation, the Attorney General is seeking access to documents and information that contain Number Resource Utilization and Forecast ("NRUF") data and local number portability ("LNP") data.


The Attorney General provides assurance to the Federal Communications Commission that all data and/or documentary evidence sought by the Attorney General will be used for legitimate law enforcement purposes associated with the proposed acquisition. The Attorney General will keep all NRUF and LNP data, and any materials containing such data, confidential to the fullest extent possible under all applicable laws, including, but not limited to, MCL 15.243 and MCL 445.776. The Attorney General will not disclose such data unless the disclosure is required by law or is required pursuant to a judicial proceeding.

Additionally, if any documents or information should become the subject of a discovery request or public records request by a third party, the Attorney General shall assert all applicable privileges, exemptions or other objections to disclosure in response to such request that the Attorney General in good faith deems appropriate under applicable law.
