Uniti Group Inc. respectfully files this letter in support of the Motion for Extension of Time (“Motion”) filed by INCOMPAS in the above docketed proceeding.

The issues raised by USTelecom’s petition are complex and require a detailed record that takes time to prepare. The Commission has previously determined that extensions are warranted when the extension is necessary to ensure that the Commission receives full and informed responses and the affected parties have an opportunity to develop a more complete record for the Commission’s consideration.<sup>1</sup> Moreover, a limited extension of time, such as that proposed by INCOMPAS will not cause undue delay or prejudice for the Commission.

For the above reasons, the Commission should grant INCOMPAS’ Motion for Extension of Time.


