On June 4, 2019, the undersigned, on behalf of Tata Communications (America) Inc. and Tata Communications (Guam), L.L.C. (together, "Tata Communications"), spoke by telephone with Karen Sprung and Claudia Fox of the Wireline Competition Bureau ("Bureau") regarding the above-referenced proceeding. I reiterated Tata Communications' need for a waiver of Section 54.706(a) or 54.706(c) of the Commission's rules and emphasized that, under either approach, Tata Communications should receive relief from the 12 percent Limited International Revenue Exemption threshold. The Bureau should promptly grant Tata Communications' unopposed petition.
